Test areas

Startup:

• Fresh install of Sakai, Profile2 (P2) starts up ok and database tables created.

General:

- Navigate to P2 with new user, check main shows up with info from Account (name and email)
- Check all pages along the top render ok when links clicked
- Click edit in panels, enter some values, save, navigate away and come back, verify info saved.
- Change values in privacy page, click Save, navigate away and come back, verify new settings.
- Change values in preferences page, click Save, navigate away and come back, verify new settings.
- Add a status update, check saved.
- Clear status update, verify removed.
- Add a profile image, verify it works.

LDAP integration:

- For an internal user, check changing email address in P2 also updates Account.
- For an external user, changing email address in P2 should be disabled.

Twitter integration:

- Add twitter details to Preferences page in P2
- Add status update, check sent to twitter (Note: clearing a status update will not clear it from Twitter)

sakai.properties:

The following are the defaults and are documented. Changing any of these should have the desired effect in P2

Enable/disable the gallery feature? (true/false, default true) profile2.gallery.enabled=true

Privacy settings:

- Change your privacy settings to only show certain info to 'connections'. As a different user that is not connected to the first user, find that user in a search. Click their profile and verify you cannot see the information they chose to hide.
- Add that user as a connection and as the other user, confirm the connection. Again as the second user, verify you can now see that information.

Preference settings:

• Change your email preferences and confirm it has the desired effect, ie you should not receive emails when someone adds you as a connection, and vice versa.

Connections:

- Perform a search and add someone as a connection.
- As the other user, confirm that connection. Verify confirmed in connection list.
- As the first user, remove that connection, verify removed.
- Add that person as a connection again (userB), as userB confirm it, and as the administrator, delete the account of userB. Verify connection has disappeared from userA's list.
